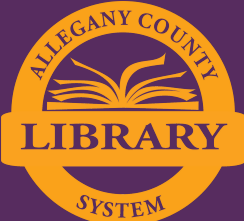

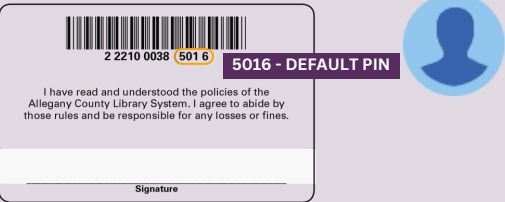

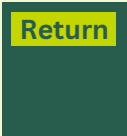
How do I renew library items?



1. Go to www.alleganycountylibrary.info
2. Click on Account
3. Login with Barcode and PIN. Your barcode is located on the back of your library card. The default PIN is the last four digits of your barcode.
4. Click on My Bookshelf
5. Click on Renew

Returning Items

- Return most items to any ACLS library (see back for locations)
- After hours book returns (book drops are available at all locations)
- Library of Things items and Chromebooks must be returned to the circulation desk at the loaning library

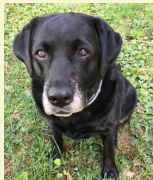

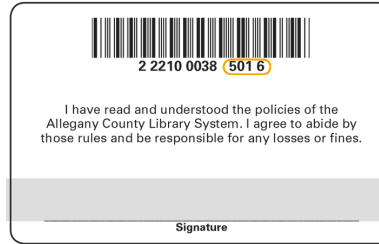
