- Digital submissions must be at least 300 PPI minimum, preferably 600 PPI.
- Do not include personal information; inappropriate content will cause submissions to be disqualified.
- Any resident of Allegany County or any out-of-state resident with a valid ACLS library card is eligible to participate.

Winners:

- Two finalists from each age group will be chosen through a public poll, and then one winner from each group will be selected by ACLS staff.
- All finalists will receive a library swag bag, a free replacement card with the winning design, and unending bragging rights! Finalists will be showcased at the LaVale Library and the winning designs will be available at all ACLS Libraries during National Library Week, while supplies last.

Digital submissions will be accepted until Monday, September 30 .	One entry per person.


Entries become property of ACLS. Winner's name may appear on promotions including, but not limited to social media, the library website, newspaper, and other communications.
