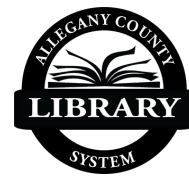


Allegany County Library System Library Card Design Contest

- Do not include personal information; inappropriate content will cause submissions to be disqualified.
- Any resident of Allegany County or any out-of-state resident with a valid ACLS library card is eligible to participate.

Winners:

- Two finalists from each age group will be chosen through a public poll, and then one winner from each group will be selected by ACLS staff.
- All finalists will receive a library swag bag, a free replacement card with the winning design, and unending bragging rights! Finalists will be showcased at the LaVale Library and the winning design will be available at all ACLS Libraries during National Library Week, while supplies last.
