In response to the temporary closure of the Westernport Library due to flooding, the Allegany County Library System is bringing essential library services directly to the community. Beginning Mondays in August, Pop-Up Libraries will be set up in the Westernport Library parking lot from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM.

Modeled after the original Pop-Up Library series launched during the COVID-19 closures, these flexible "mini libraries" are designed to bring the library experience to you. And best of all, you'll be greeted by the familiar, friendly faces of your regional library staff, ready to help you stay connected while the library building is being restored.

- Get personalized reading recommendations from staff who know your favorites
